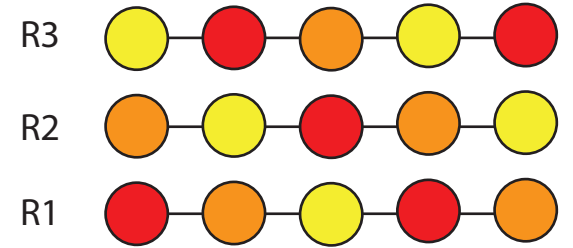
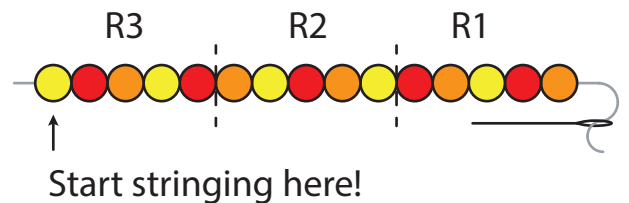


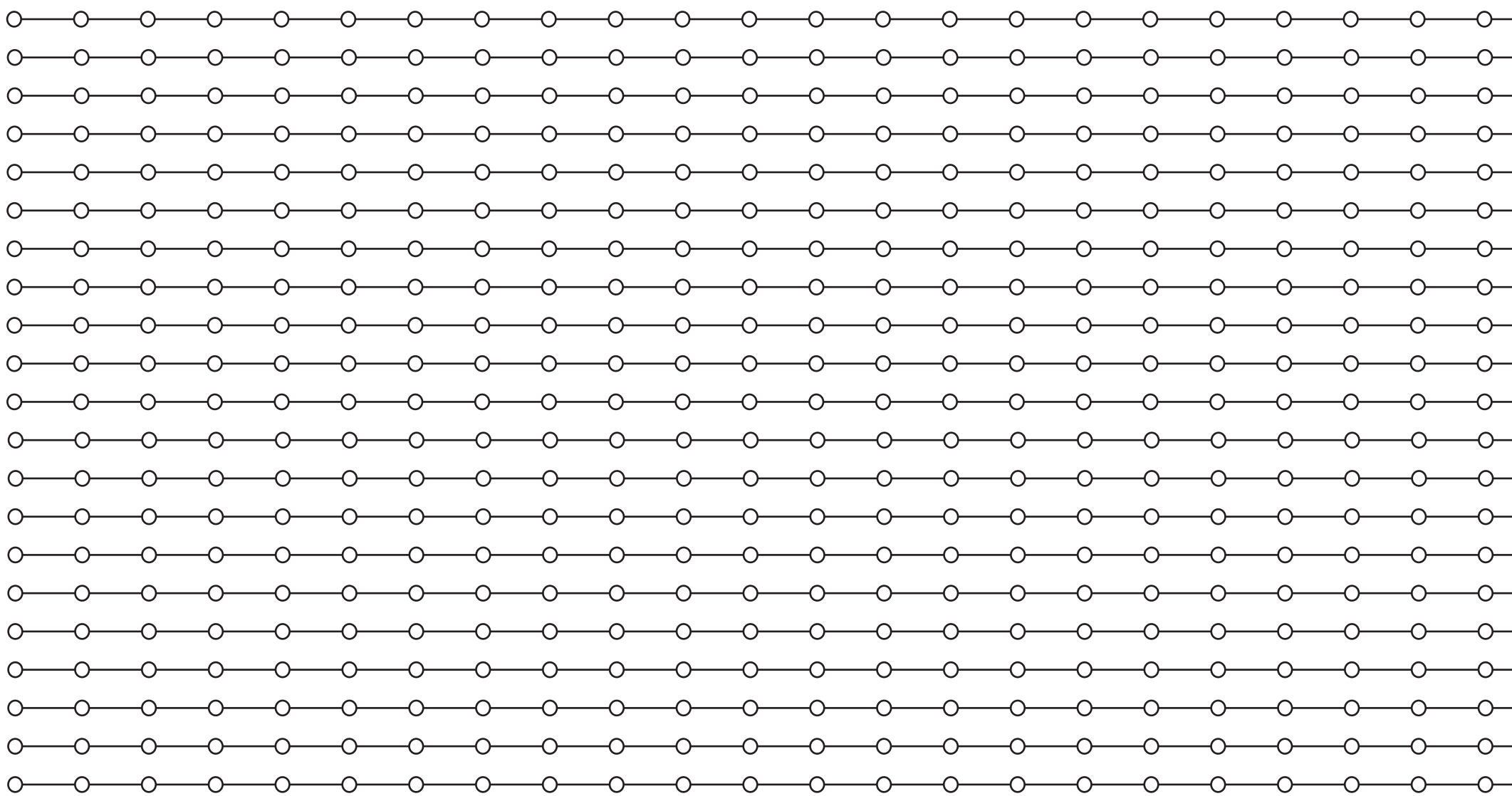
HOW TO STRING THE BEADS IN A PATTERN



If you want to make the example pattern above, string the beads from left to right starting with the top row. Once you've finished that row, start with the most left bead from the row below.

Please keep in mind that you don't want to string more than ~200 beads at a time. So I suggest stringing beads per 4 rows (which means, start stringing the most left beads in row 4, crochet the beads into the shawl, cut yarn, string a new sequence of beads starting with the most left bead in row 8 etc.).
